Very good speaker.

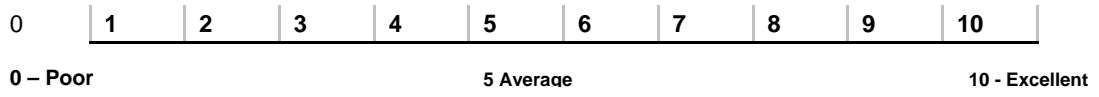
Useful afternoon – good to have question and answer session for sexual health. Good thoughts on risk and how we communicate it.
