Very good, thanks.

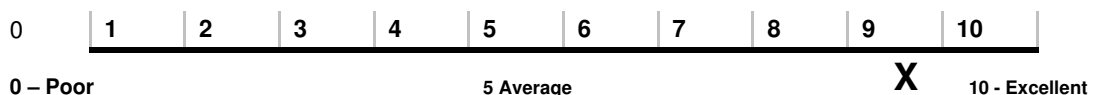
Sue was excellent. Great CSA talk. Great on AA A screening – might be useful to have a follow up.
